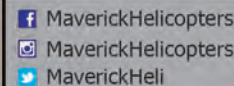


EXPERIENCE HAWAII FROM NEW HEIGHTS

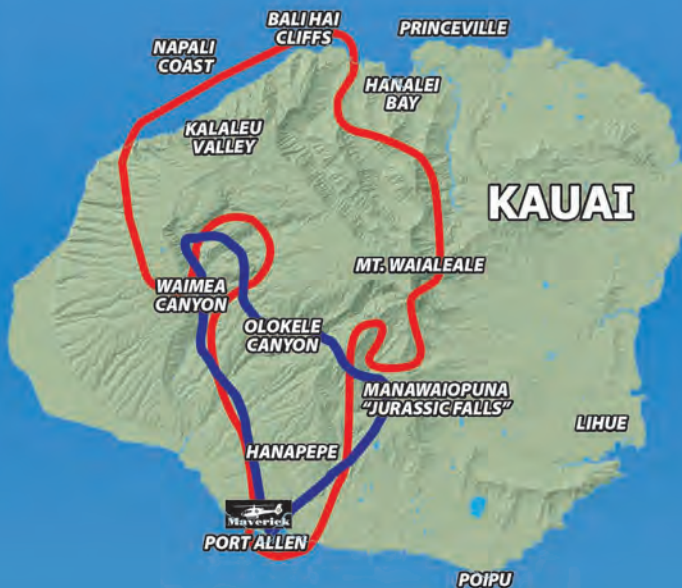
